WATCH OUT FOR HOLIDAY GIFT CARD SCAMS



The holidays are fast approaching and, unfortunately, scammers aren't far behind. In order to avoid losing out on your hard-earned money, or facing the embarrassment of gifting a fake gift card, here are some recommendations from the Federal Trade Commission.

- **1. Only shop at trusted stores.** This isn't the time to explore online auction sites or Facebook Marketplace. You may think you're getting a deal, but you're likely getting a fraud!
- **2. Inspect the gift card.** Make sure the pin number on the back isn't showing and the protective stickers are still intact. If it looks tampered with at all, get a different card.
- **3. Keep a record.** Write down the card's ID number and keep the receipt so you can file a report if you lose it, or if it ends up being fraudulent.

Remember to never pay for a service or a "prize" using a gift card. The only reason someone would request this form of payment is to avoid being caught in a scam. No government agency or legitimate company would ask you to pay them with a gift card.

If you fall prey to a gift card scam, report it to the Federal Trade Commission at ReportFraud.ftc.gov. If you lost money due to a scam, report it to local law enforcement and to your state attorney general.
