

At Olean Area FCU, we understand the seriousness of the situation in Ukraine and the security concerns it has raised in New York, across the country, and globally. While we hope the military escalation ends swiftly and peacefully, it is important to reassure that your money is secure with our credit union.

The safest place for your money is in your credit union account. There are many risks to having cash in hand. Olean Area FCU is strong and can withstand this type of global crisis, just as we did at the start of the pandemic. All credit union deposits are insured up to \$250,000 per account through the National Credit Union Association (NCUA). This insurance is the exact same that banks have with the FDIC.

During times like these, it is important for you to be extra vigilant with your finances. Olean Area FCU has your best interest in mind and we can help you identify different



types of scams and ways to avoid them. Information regarding prevalent scams are available on our website and social media pages. If you think you may have been a victim of fraud, please contact our Member Service department immediately so we can further investigate for you. As always, when it comes to keeping your money safe, we're here for you.

KEEP US UPDATED!

PEI DRIVER'S LICENSE

It's important to keep the CU updated with a current copy of your driver's license. If you have renewed your license in the last few months, or are scheduled to renew in 2022, you can have any teller or member service representative scan it into our system for you!

☐ CELL PHONE NUMBER

One of the easiest ways to respond to our Fraud Monitoring Service is by cell phone. If you have a suspect transaction, the first way they reach out is via text. If you are in fact making a purchase, respond to the text and you will be able to proceed with your transaction.

ADDRESS CHANGE

Stop in or go online in eTeller to update your address as soon as it changes. This will ensure your CU statements, ATM cards, debit cards, credit cards and check orders go to the right place!

NOW OFFERING DIGITAL WALLETS!

Securely store your Olean Area FCU debit or credit Visa® card in your phone's digital wallet for quick checkouts when shopping in store or online. It makes purchases easy, convenient, and secure!

Any information you store in your digital wallet is encrypted, meaning it's likely more secure than carrying cards around with you. Your card number isn't stored on the device, nor is it given to merchants. Instead, they get a one-time transaction code.

MAD CITY MONEY IS BACK!

High school seniors at Cuba-Rushford were introduced to a "real world" financial education experience this March. In the Mad City Money program, students start out by choosing an "identity," that lists their occupation, salary, spouse, children, and debts. They then have to visit various stations to choose housing, transportation, daycare, food, and other necessities while sticking to their budget. Students learn how to calculate their credit card monthly payment, write a check, and adjust their budget when unexpected expenses or financial gains arise.

Cuba-Rushford students had the opportunity to voice their takeaways at the end of the program. "Kids are expensive!", one student exclaimed. "I now have a better understanding of why my parents make the financial decisions they do," another student said.
